



DLR Discovery Treasure Hunt

How to take part

Join the DLR Discovery Treasure Hunt this summer with our mascots DLR Dave and Doris! Help them find the treasures hidden around London's Docklands starting at Tower Gateway DLR station.

1. Download the app Actionbound on your smartphone & create an account. The app is available in The App Store for iOS users and Google Play for Android users.
2. Search for 'DLR Treasure Hunt' or scan a starting QR code at Tower Gateway station concourse.
3. Follow instructions on the app and scan codes for individual treasures hidden on DLR stations shown on the Treasure Hunt map.
4. Discover Docklands history and surroundings while answering quiz questions and completing various tasks. You can complete your Treasure Hunt in one day or across various days. Make sure you complete your Treasure Hunt by the 5th of September.
5. Once you completed your Treasure Hunt head back to Tower Gateway station to collect your prize (our Treasure Stop is opened daily 10am-6pm).
6. Scan the QR code below to start your Treasure Hunt experience. Don't forget, no treasures are hidden on trains, platforms or tracks.

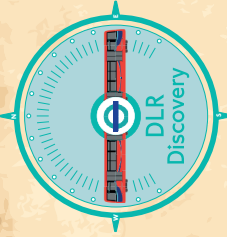

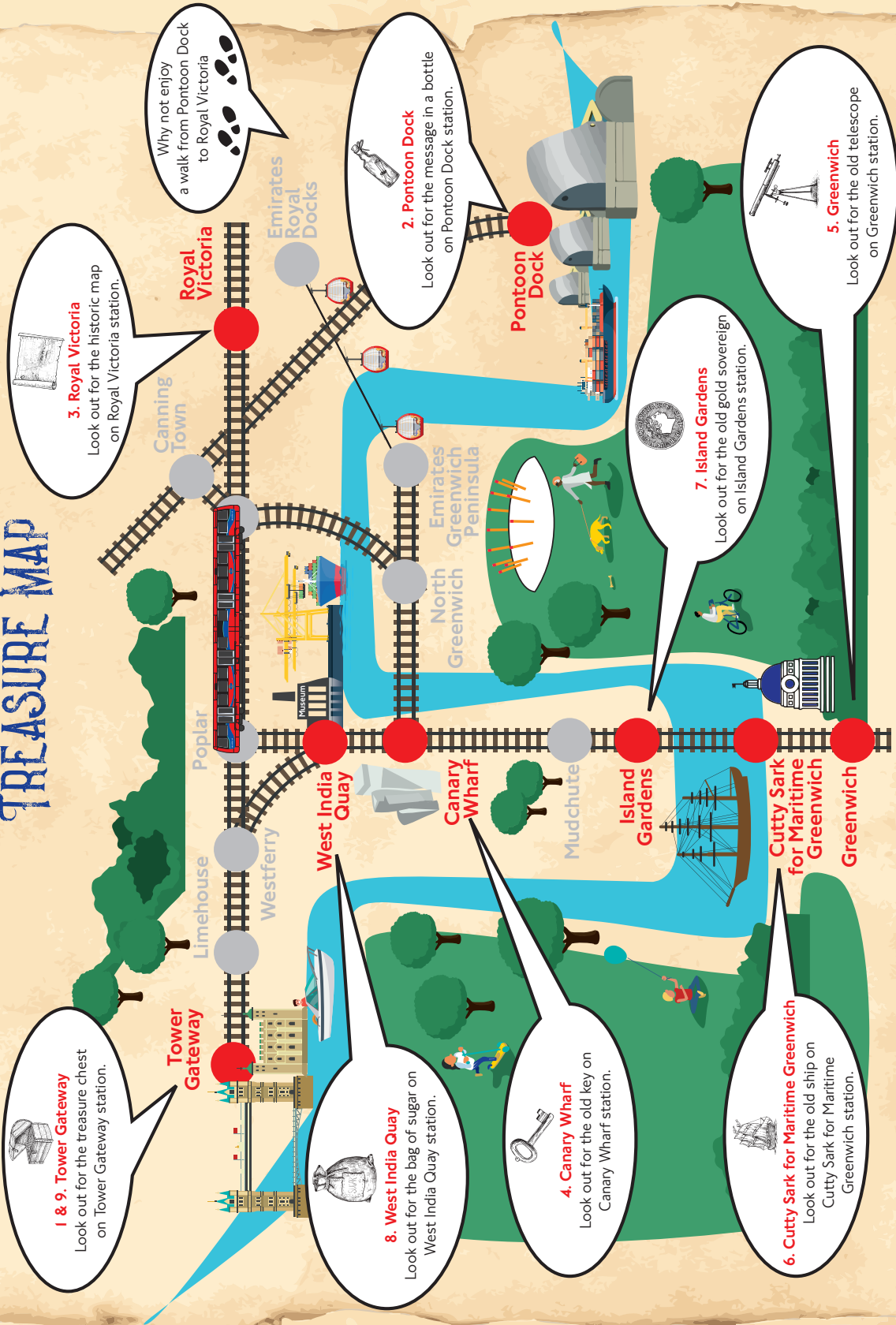


TREASURE MAP

1 & 9. Tower Gateway
Look out for the treasure chest on Tower Gateway station.

8. West India Quay
Look out for the bag of sugar on West India Quay station.

4. Canary Wharf
Look out for the old key on Canary Wharf station.

6. Cutty Sark for Maritime Greenwich
Look out for the old ship on Cutty Sark for Maritime Greenwich station.

3. Royal Victoria
Look out for the historic map on Royal Victoria station.

2. Pontoon Dock
Look out for the message in a bottle on Pontoon Dock station.

7. Island Gardens
Look out for the old gold sovereign on Island Gardens station.

5. Greenwich
Look out for the old telescope on Greenwich station.
